

Chromatic scales exercises

E Chromatic scale

The image displays two guitar tablature exercises for an E chromatic scale. The first exercise is an ascending scale starting on the open E string (fret 0) and moving up to the open E string of the next octave (fret 12). The fret numbers for each string are: 0-1-2-3-4 for the low E string, 0-1-2-3-4 for the A string, 0-1-2-3 for the D string, and 0-1-2-3-4 for the high E string. The second exercise is a descending scale starting on the open E string of the next octave (fret 12) and moving down to the open E string (fret 0).
